Species at Risk

FBS conducts long term research, inventory and monitoring of provincial/federal Species at Risk. The Frontenac Arch, one of only 19 UNESCO biosphere reserves in Canada, is a uniquely important area for many species, including the Cerulean Warbler pictured above.



Emerging Threats

Long term datasets are critical for supporting the protection of ecological integrity from development, such as the proposed Alto high speed rail project, which threatens the Frontenac Arch region, its biodiversity and connectivity.
